



## Application to correct award

## **Contractors State License Board Voluntary / Mandatory Arbitration Program**

**TO PARTIES AT INTEREST, IN THE MATTER OF:**

California Business and Professions Code Section 7085.5 provides for correction of a binding arbitration

only under the following conditions:

(s) The award shall become final 30 calendar days from the date the arbitration award is issued. The arbitrator, upon written application of a party to the arbitration, may correct the award on the following grounds:

the award upon the following grounds:

- (1) There was an evident miscalculation of figures or an evident mistake in the description of any person, things, or property referred to in the award.
- (2) There is any other clerical error in the award, not affecting the merits of the controversy.

An application for correction of the award shall be made within 10 calendar days of the date of service of the award by serving a copy of the application on the arbitrator, and all other parties to the arbitration. Any party to the arbitration may make a written objection to the application for correction by serving a copy of the written objection on the arbitrator, the board, and all other parties to the arbitration, within 10 calendar days of the date of service of the application for correction.

The arbitrator shall either deny the application or correct the award within 30 calendar days of the date of service of the original award by mailing a copy of the denial or correction to all parties to the arbitration.
